




You have the freedom of speech and religion and to petition.



You can "bear arms" for self defense




You do not have to house a soldier during war.

You do not have to admit you did a crime.




You can request a lawyer, have a jury with no delay, and you can know who your accuser is.


Amendment 6 Allows You The Right To:









Anybody with a fine over \$20 can request a trial.



You cannot receive any cruel or unusual punishments.




Even if a right is not directly referred to in the Constitution, it does not mean that right is denied.
